PROGRAM OVERVIEW

The OCSI middle school program is designed for students in grades 6 through 8. The program provides a collaborative and challenging curriculum with exciting projects and hands-on learning experiences. Core classes include English, Social Studies, Science, Math and Bible. Elective courses include Physical Education, Japanese, Digital Tools, Music, Art, and Woodshop. In addition, each student receives a Chromebook as part of our 1:1 laptop program.

- Science: Earth Science (6); Life Science (7); Physical Science (8)
- Social Studies: World History Survey

- Bible: Old & New Testament (6); Biblical Principles (7); New Testament Survey (8)
